A multi-building project that included the 4th Avenue Jail, an adult detention facility totaling 615,000 SF and 1,993 beds; the Lower Buckeye Maximum-Security Jail and Central Services with 2,512 beds and 654,000 SF; two juvenile detention facilities and a courthouse (Durango and Mesa) consisting of 379,000 SF and 388 beds; a 60,000 SF Forensic Science Center; a 26,000 SF Estrella Support Building; a 32,000 SF Residential Treatment Center; and three parking structures totaling more than 1 million SF and over 2,300 parking spaces.
