A 314,000 SF renovation to the existing Brooke Army Medical Center and a 750,000 SF, seven story bed tower addition with a helipad, four-story ancillary care center, a three-story clinic. Project also includes a 1,700,000 SF, 5,000-car parking garage and a 33,000 SF central plant. Once complete, the facility will house 425 inpatient beds, 32 operating rooms, a level 1 Trauma/Emergency Room, medical, pediatric and surgical subspecialty clinics, primary care, labor, delivery, recovery, neonatal intensive care unit and pediatric intensive care unit, bone marrow and organ transplant centers and new centers of excellence in cardio-vascular, maternal-child and battlefield health and trauma.
